Subject: Management of Federal Awards

In anticipation of mandatory federal grant reporting requirements which may be implemented under the Digital Accountability and Transparency Act of 2012 (DATA Act) recently passed out of the U.S. House of Representatives, and to improve the State's federal grant management process, we need to compile a complete and accurate inventory of federal awards that have been awarded to each state entity.

We are therefore requiring that each state entity provide the following information by e-mail to manderson@dbedt.hawaii.gov by June 4, 2012:

1. Please list on the attached worksheet (STATE INVENTORY OF FEDERAL AWARDS) each open federal award that you have been awarded as the prime recipient to date. DO NOT list stimulus awards you were awarded under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA). Please complete all fields and do not make any changes to the worksheet. The list of awards that you provided to the Legislature on the WAM/FIN budget worksheet Table 16 is attached for your reference.

The term 'federal award' means federal financial assistance and expenditures that include (a) grants, sub-grants, loans, awards, cooperative agreements, and other forms of financial assistance; and (b) include contracts, subcontracts, purchase orders, task orders, delivery orders, blanket purchase agreements, schedule orders, and other transactions.
