2 appropriation for the office of the governor (GOV100):

3 (1) The sum of \$20,000 or so much thereof as may be
4 necessary for fiscal year 2014-2015 shall be expended to pay
5 dues to the Education Commission of the States; and

6 (2) If \$20,000 is not expended to pay the dues in fiscal
7 year 2014-15, then the difference between \$20,000 and the
8 expended amount shall lapse into the general fund on June 30,
9 2014."
