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- constitute a credit to the State against the costs of acquiring 1
- all or any portion of the property, real, personal, or mixed, of
- such non-governmental agency. This credit shall be applicable 3
- regardless of when such acquisition takes place. 4
- SECTION 100. Any provision of this Act to the contrary 5
- 6 notwithstanding, the federal fund or other federal fund
- appropriations made for operating costs authorized under this 7
- Act shall not lapse at the end of the fiscal year for which the 8
- appropriation is made; provided that all federal fund or other 9
- federal fund appropriations made to be expended in fiscal 10
- year 2015-2016 which are unencumbered as of June 30, 2018, shall 11
- lapse as of that date and fiscal year 2016-2017 which are 12
- unencumbered as of June 30, 2019, shall lapse as of that date. 13
- SECTION 101. If unanticipated federal funding cutbacks 14
- 15 diminish or curtail essential, federally-funded state programs,
- the governor may utilize savings as determined to be available 16
- from other state programs for the purpose of maintaining such 17
- programs until the next legislative session; provided that the 18
- governor shall notify the legislature within five days of each 19
- use of this authority and submit a report to the legislature of 20
- all uses of this authority for the previous twelve month period 21
- from December 1 to November 30 no later than thirty days prior 22
- to the convening of the regular sessions of 2016 and 2017. 23
