4 SECTION 32. The governor may approve the expenditure of
5 all federal funds that are in excess of levels authorized by the
6 legislature; provided that the governor may allow for an
7 increase in the appropriate federal fund authorization ceiling
8 for the program to accommodate the expenditure of the funds;
9 provided further that the governor shall notify the legislature
10 within five days of each use of this authority and submit a
11 report to the legislature of all uses of this authority for the
12 previous twelve month period from December 1 to November 30 no
13 later than thirty days prior to the convening of the regular
14 sessions of 2020 and 2021.

15 SECTION 33. Any provision of this Act to the contrary
16 notwithstanding, the governor may approve the extension of the
17 lapse dates for federal fund or other federal fund
18 appropriations and appropriations of other means of financing,
19 except general funds, deemed necessary to qualify for federal
20 aid financing or reimbursement, or both, provided in this Act or



1 authorized by the governor pursuant to section 32 of this Act as
2 necessary to meet the intent of the federal grant awards.

3 SECTION 34. Where an agency is authorized to secure funds
4 or other property from private organizations or individuals to
5 be expended or utilized in connection with any authorized
6 program, the agency, with the governor's approval, may enter
7 into the undertaking; provided that the provisions of the
8 undertaking comply with applicable state constitutional and
9 statutory requirements; provided further that the governor shall
10 submit a report to the legislature of all uses of this authority
11 for the previous twelve month period from December 1 to November
12 30 no later than thirty days prior to the convening of the
13 regular sessions of 2020 and 2021.

14 SECTION 35. Except as otherwise provided by general law,
15 negotiations for the purchase of land by state agencies shall be
16 subject to the approval of the governor and the department of
17 land and natural resources or other appropriate agency; provided
18 that private lands may be acquired for the purpose of exchange
19 for federal lands when the department of land and natural
20 resources and the governor determine that the acquisition and
