

1 SECTION 63. Whenever the expending agency to which an
2 appropriation is made is changed due to legislation enacted
3 during any session of the legislature that affects the
4 appropriations made by this Act, the governor shall transfer the
5 necessary funds and positions to the proper expending agency as
6 provided by law.

7 SECTION 64. If the State should assume the direct
8 operation of any non-governmental agency receiving state funds
9 under the provisions of this Act, all related state funds shall
10 constitute a credit to the State against the costs of acquiring
11 all or any portion of the property, real, personal, or mixed, of
12 the non-governmental agency. This credit shall be applicable
13 regardless of when the acquisition takes place.

14 SECTION 65. Any provision of this Act to the contrary
15 notwithstanding, the federal fund or other federal fund
16 appropriations made for operating costs authorized under this
17 Act for fiscal year 2021-2022 shall not lapse at the end of the
18 fiscal year for which the appropriation is made; provided that
19 all federal fund or other federal fund appropriations made to be
20 expended in fiscal year 2021-2022 which are unencumbered as of
21 June 30, 2023 shall lapse as of that date; and provided further



1 that the governor shall notify the legislature within five days
2 of each use of this authority and submit a report to the
3 legislature of all uses of this authority for the previous
4 fiscal year no later than September 1 of each year.

5 SECTION 66. If unanticipated federal funding cutbacks
6 diminish or curtail essential, federally funded state programs,
7 the governor may utilize savings as may be available from other
8 state programs for the purpose of maintaining the pre-existing
9 funding levels of the programs until July 1 of the immediately
10 succeeding fiscal year; provided that the governor may not use
11 this authority beyond July 1 of the immediately succeeding
12 fiscal year for which the need is initially identified; provided
13 further the governor shall submit a request to the legislature
14 for the continued supplemental funding of the essential
15 federally funded programs that have been funded pursuant to this
16 section no later than thirty days prior to the convening of the
17 regular sessions of 2022 and 2023; and provided further that the
18 governor shall notify the legislature within five days of each
19 use of this authority and submit a report to the legislature of
20 all uses of this authority for the previous fiscal year no later
21 than September 1 of each year.
